Development/remedial courses (courses number 001-099) CANNOT be used to satisfy graduation requirements. These courses; however, must be taken as determined by placement scores as required by KCTCS policies on mandatory placement.

A student will be eligible for an additional degree when the student has completed the requirements of the second curriculum including a minimum of six (6) additional hours relevant to the second degree and has applied for the degree.
